FEES

Until 16 Jul 2004, the registration fee will be \$300 CAD (\$150 students; \$150 spouse/guest). On-site registration fees will be \$350 CAD (\$200 students; \$200 spouse/guest). Members are encouraged to register early by using the online, secure registration page at the Meeting's website at <http://www.sbf.ulaval.ca/aou-soc-2004/>. A confirmation notice will automatically be sent.

Because of the substantial discount given to students and postdocs (who have obtained a PhD less than 2 years before 16 August 2004), if you are registering as a student/postdoc you **MUST** bring your ID to check-in upon your arrival at the congress venue.

SPECIAL EVENTS

WHERE TO STAY

Campus housing registration is a separate process, run by the host University.
