

**Dr Leanne Grieves**' multidisciplinary work focuses on chemical signaling and microbial ecology in birds, overturning 'common knowledge' by establishing that chemical signatures of preen oil convey information about species, sex, reproductive status, disease exposure, and immune genotype. Grieves is a recipient of a Vanier scholarship, Gilles Brassard Prize for Interdisciplinary Research, Royal Society of Canada Alice Wilson Award, and an NSERC postdoctoral fellowship. Grieves has mentored numerous student researchers and chairs SCO-SOC's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Committee, spearheading initiatives such as the Student Discovery Award for equity-deserving groups. Dr. Grieve's is this year's recipient of the SCO-SOC's Early Career Researcher Award.
